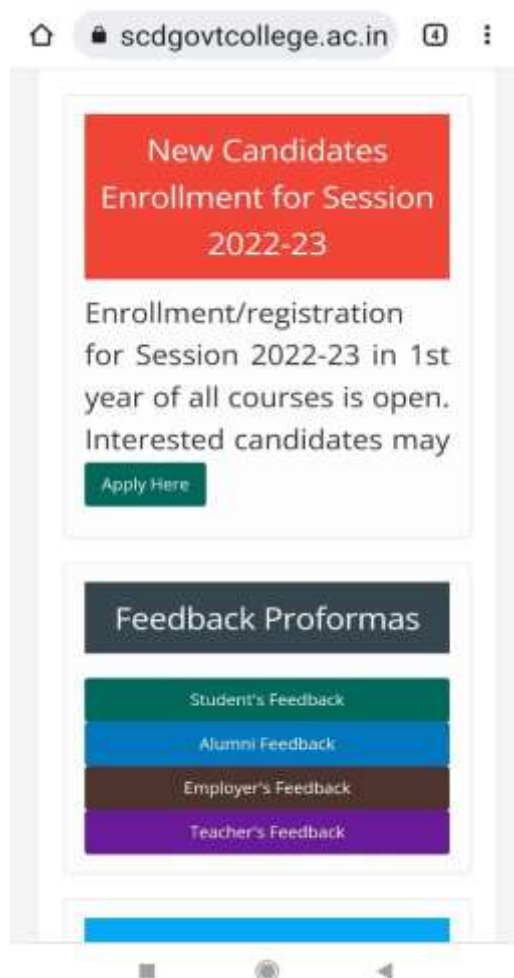

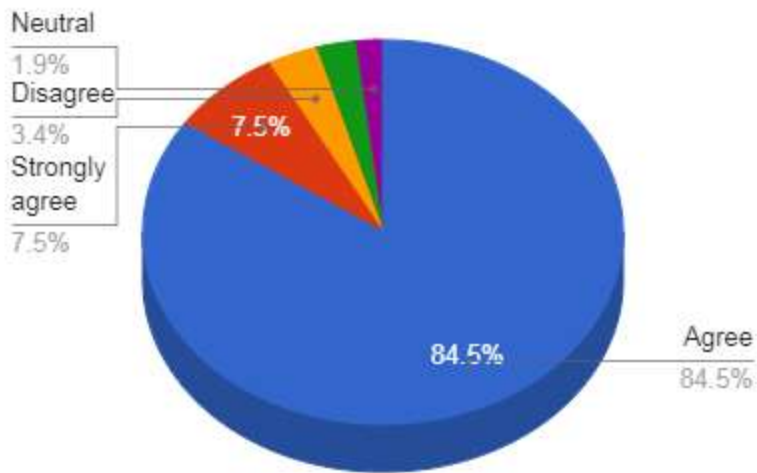


Student Feedback

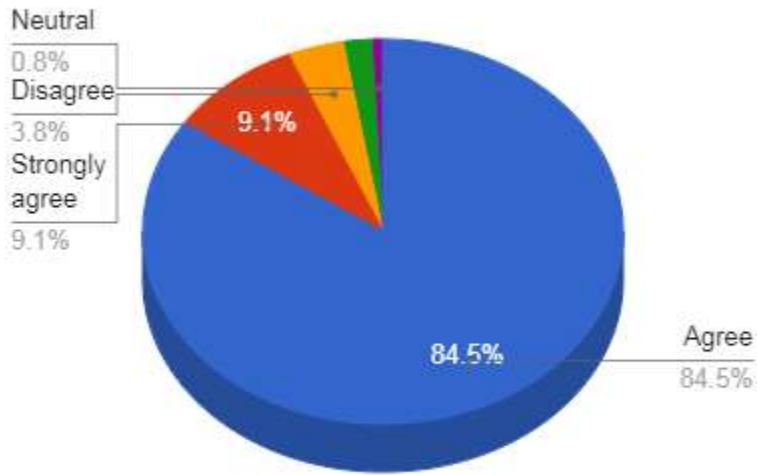

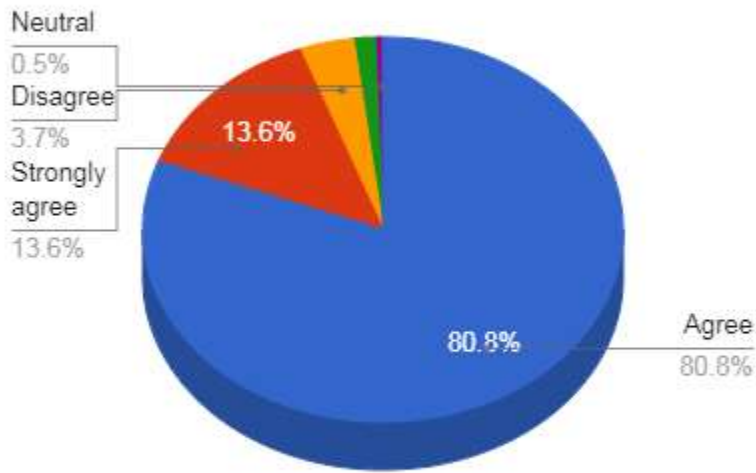

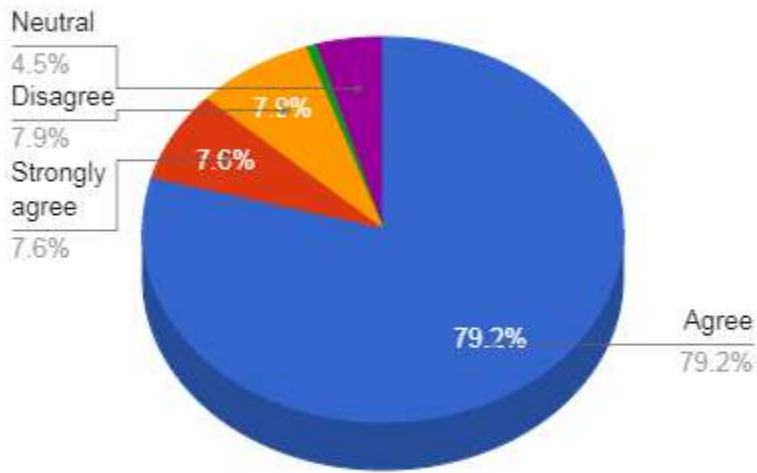

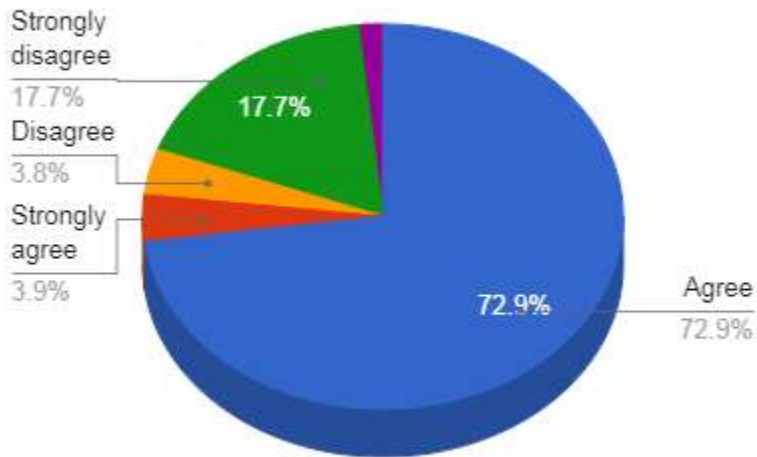

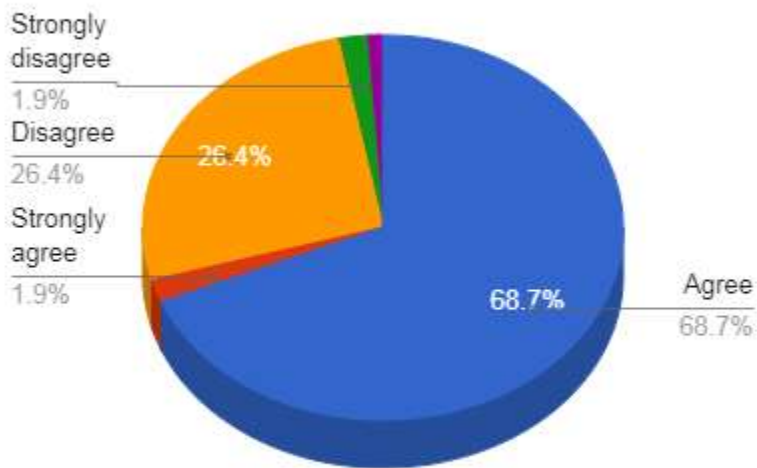

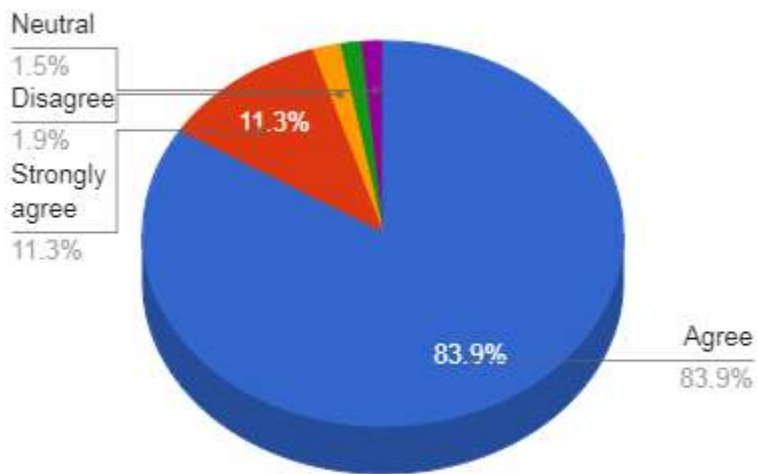

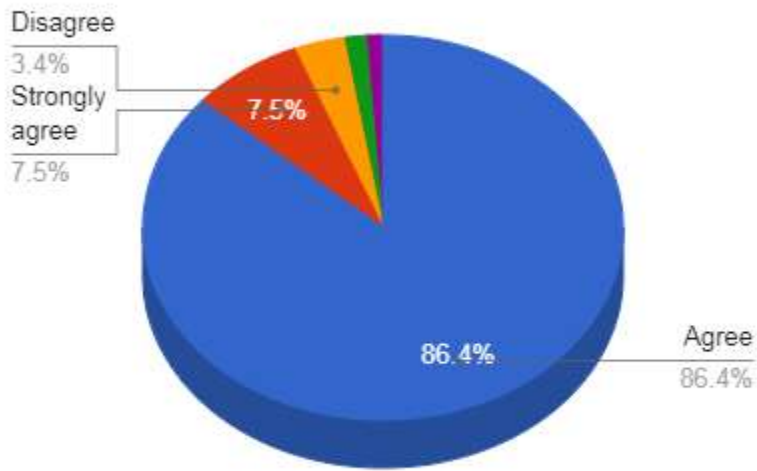

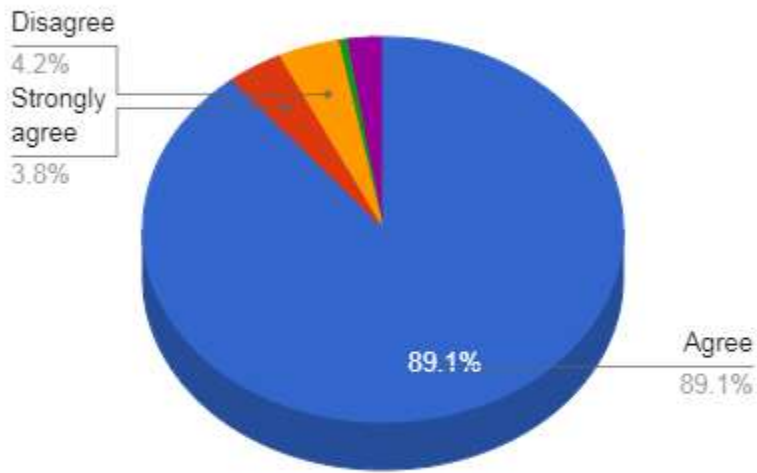

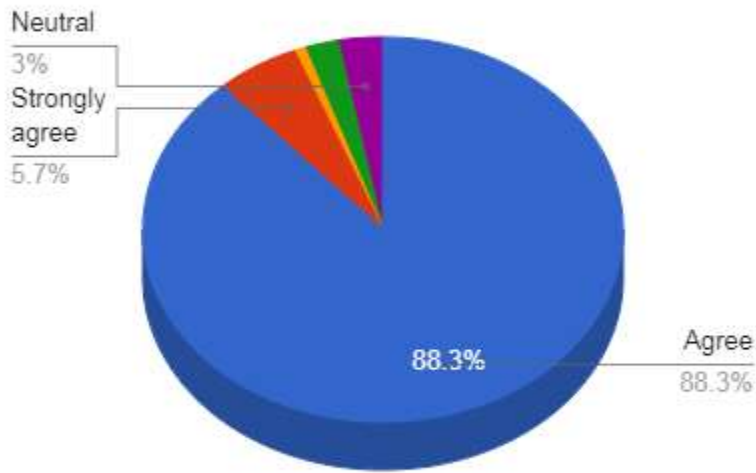

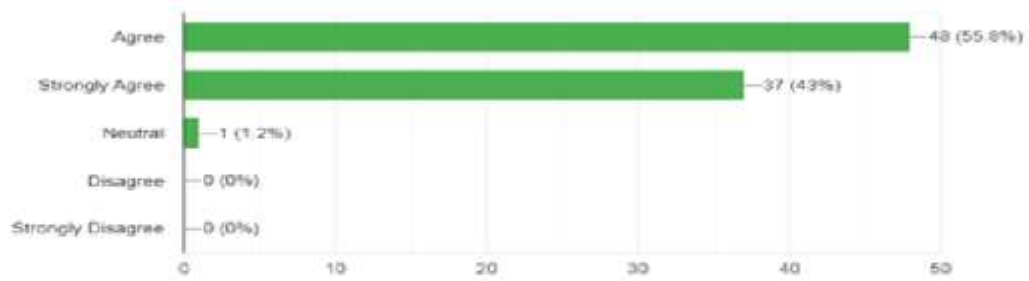

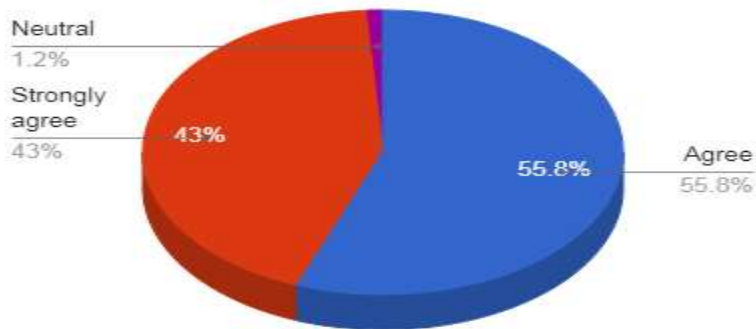

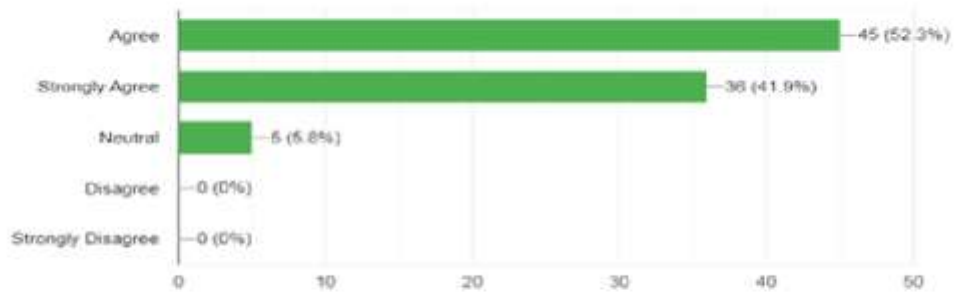

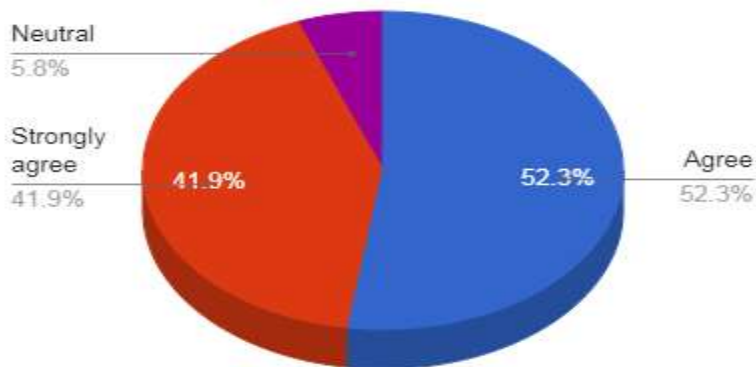

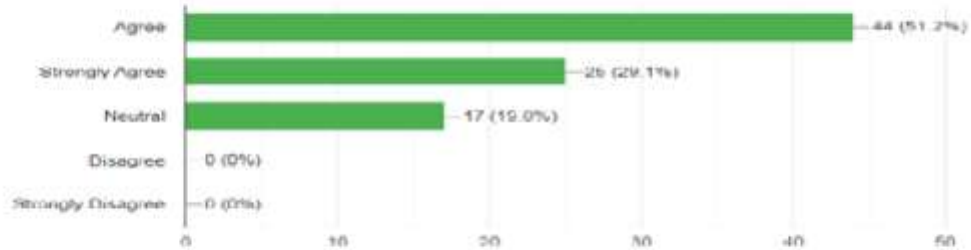

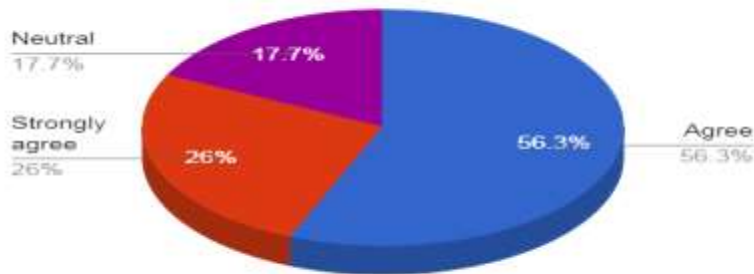

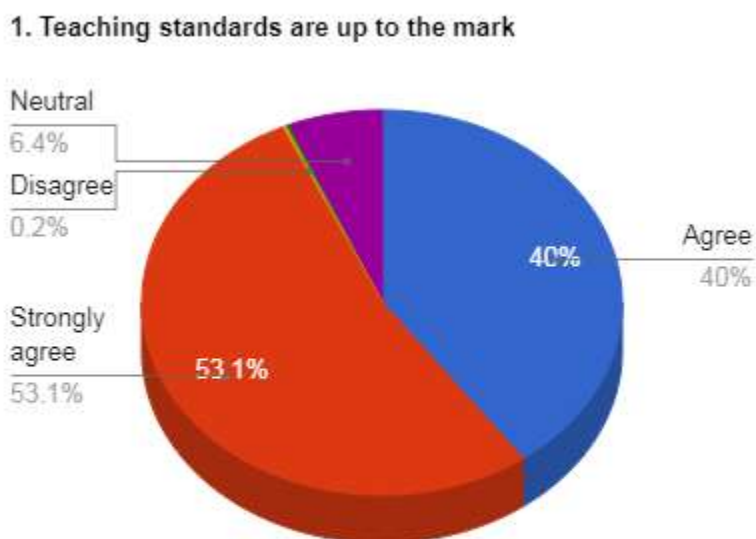

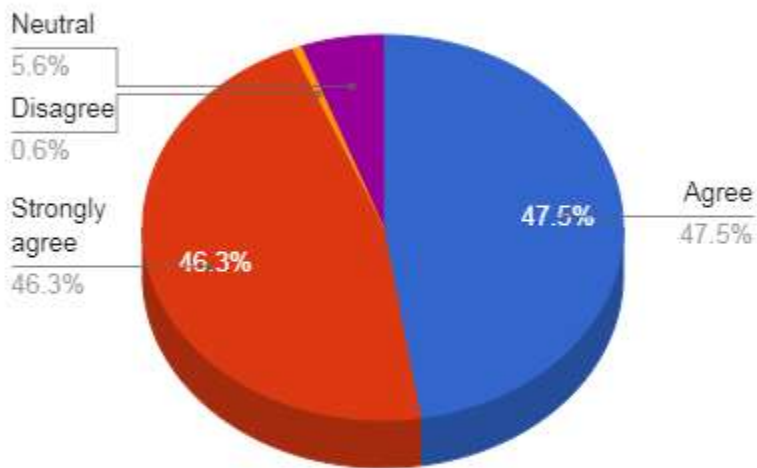

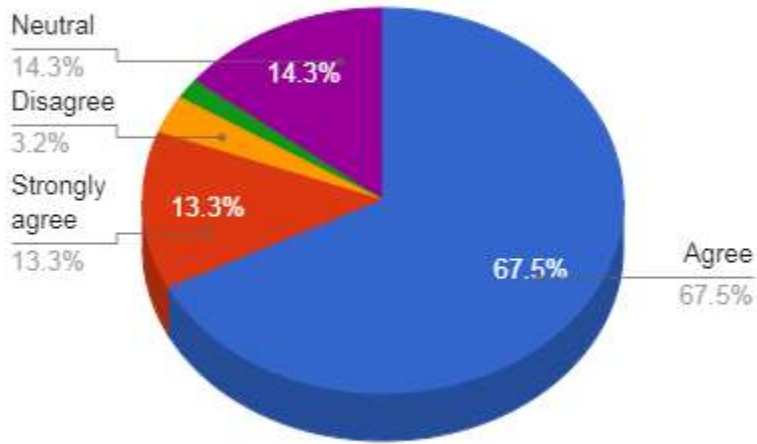

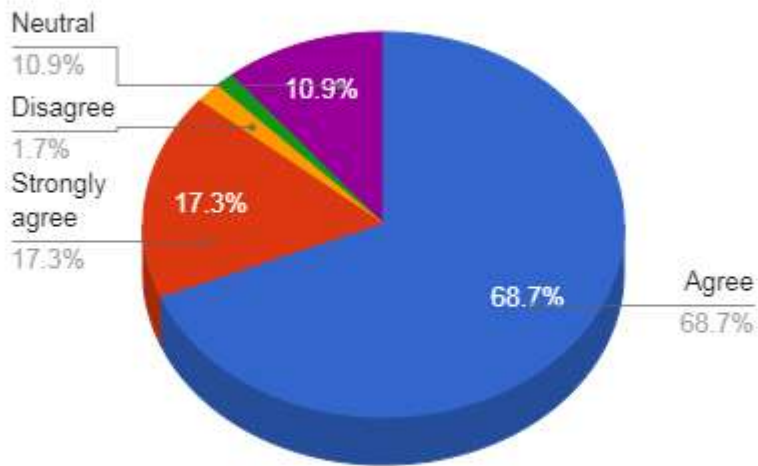

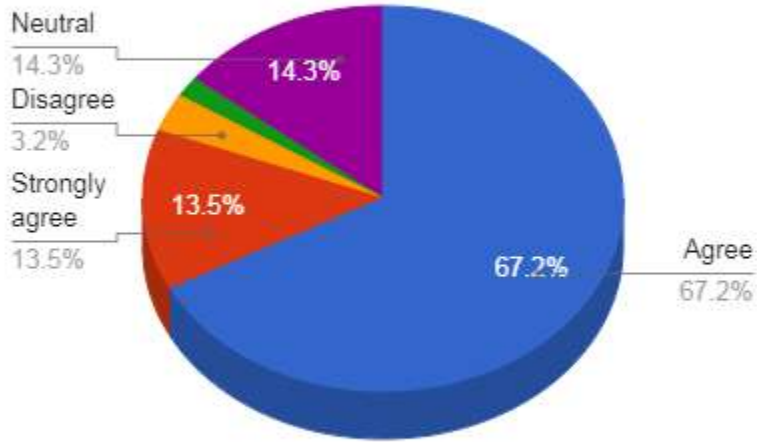

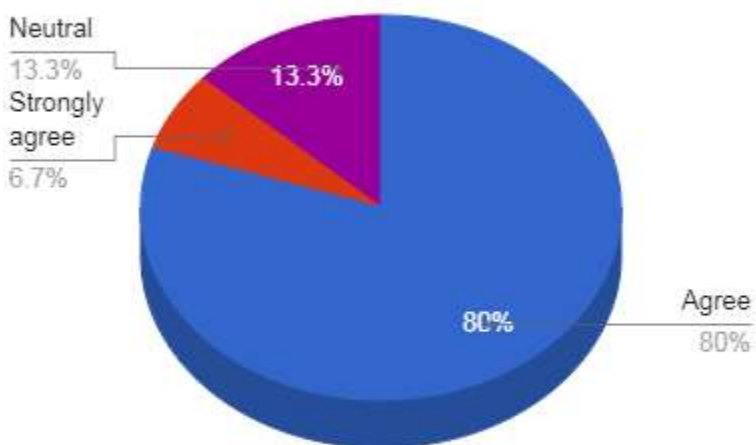

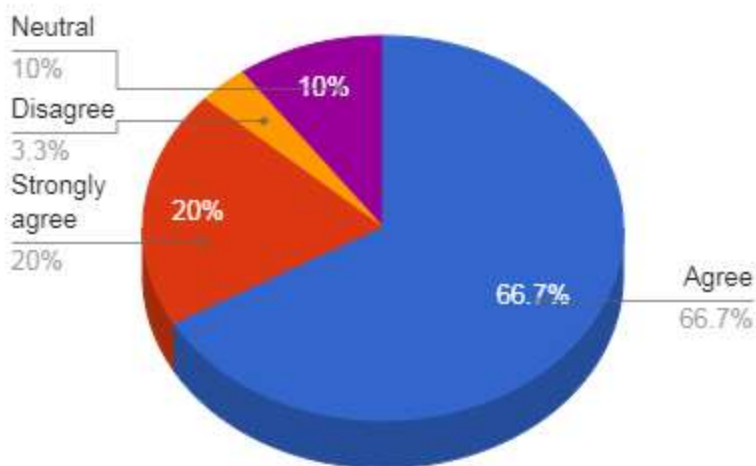

1. The trainee was punctual during his/her training.



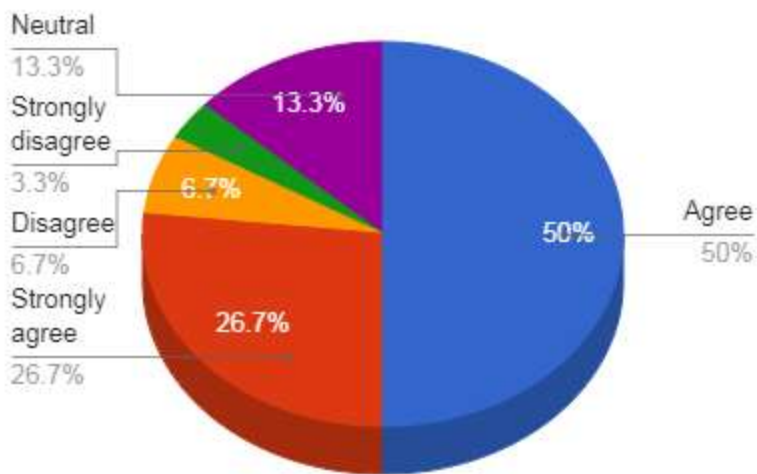

2. The trainee exhibited courtesy with staff and customers.



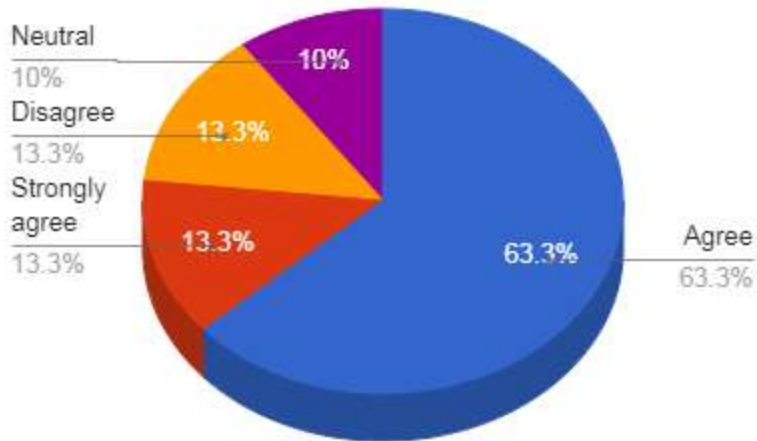

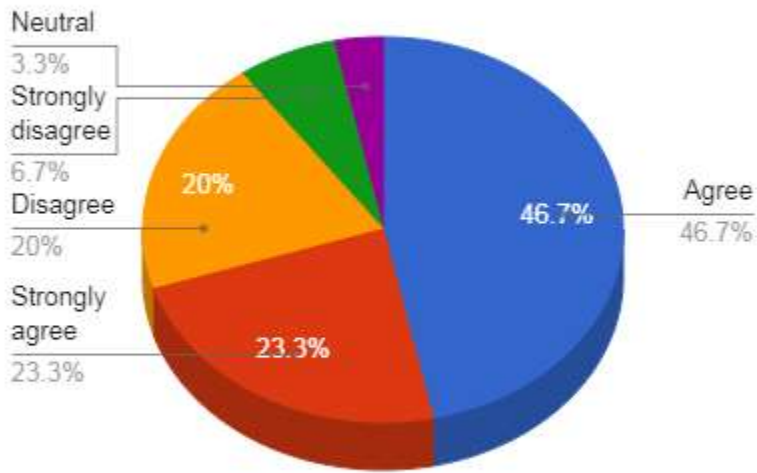

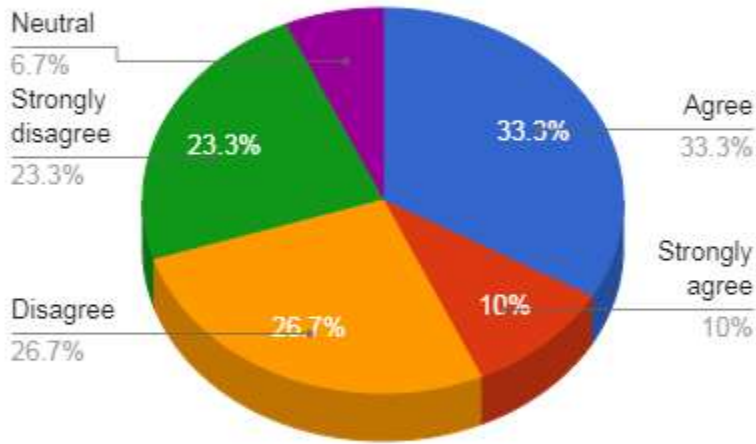

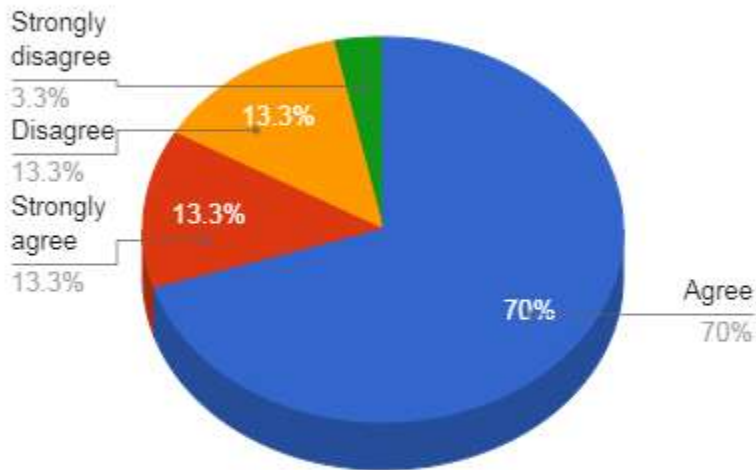

4. Water coolers need repair. Shortage of clean drinking water.
5. More solar panels and solar street lights required.
4. Departments need strong Wi-Fi facility in the wake of online classes.
5. Students dissatisfied with the online mode of instructions.

Actions taken

1. Teachers and students donated books in the Book Bank of the college which were made available for the needy students.
2. Multimedia projector installed in Economics department.
3. Chemistry and Physics labs renovated/upgraded.
4. Water coolers and water filters installed.
5. Solar panels and solar street lights installed.
6. College building renovated.
7. Different departments got Wi-fi installed.

8. Seminars held for facilitating students to cope up with online mode of instructions / practicals/ summer training in the wake of COVID -19
9. Virtual camps and workshops organized.
